Gabriel Visits Mary

Luke 1:26-38; Matthew 1:18-25



- Mary was betrothed to a man named Joseph. Both Mary and Joseph were descendants of King David.
- The angel, Gabriel, appeared to Mary before she married Joseph. He told her not to be afraid, but rather to rejoice, because she was favored by God and she would bear a Son.
- This Son would be called Jesus; He would be the Son of God, and He would sit on the throne of David forever.
- When Mary asked how this would happen, the angel told her that the Spirit of God would come upon her.
- Mary answered, “Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to Your word.”
