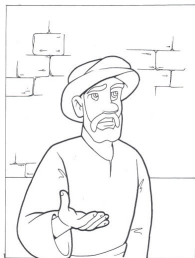

# Jesus & Nicodemus

John 3:1-21

- Nicodemus was a Pharisee. Most of the Pharisees did not believe that Jesus was sent by God, but Nicodemus did.
- Nicodemus came to Jesus by night to talk to him about the kingdom of God. Jesus told him that being a good person could not get anyone into God's kingdom, but that he needed to be born again by the Spirit of God in order to enter the kingdom of heaven.
- Jesus then told him that the way to be born again by the Spirit was to believe in God's Son that was sent to die for the whole world.

- What does it mean to be born again?
- How do you become born again?
- Is it true that you must be born again to have your sins forgiven?
- Why was God's Son sent to die for the whole world?

### What does it mean to me:

- Do you want to live with God in heaven someday?
- What must you do to be born again?
- Why did God send his Son into the world?
- Would you like to ask Jesus to be your Savior so that when you die you can live with Him in heaven? You can do that right now.
