Jesus Heals Blind Bartimaeus

Mark 10:46-52; Luke 18:35-43

- When Jesus came near Jericho on His way to Jerusalem, a blind beggar named Bartimaeus called out for Jesus to show mercy on him. He called Him “Jesus, Son of David.” This was a name for the Messiah.
- Jesus stopped, called for Bartimaeus, and asked him what he desired. Bartimaeus said he wanted to see. Jesus told Bartimaeus that because of his faith in Him, he would see.
- Immediately, Bartimaeus received his sight. He followed Jesus, glorifying God.

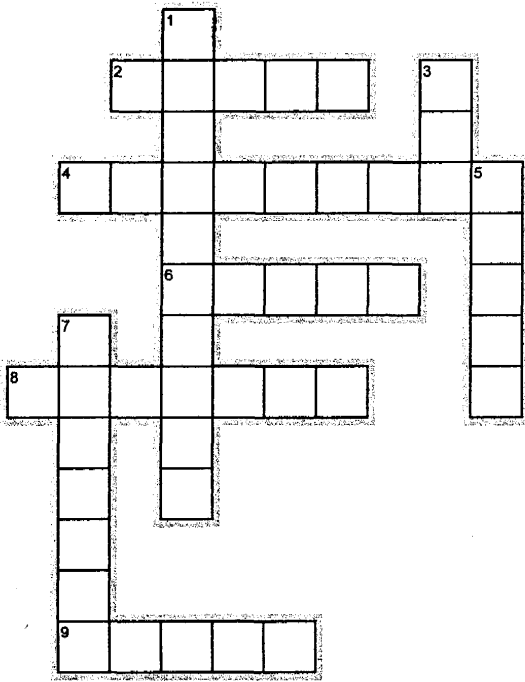
