The Children of Israel Leave Egypt

Exodus 12:31-51

- Moses said to the elders of Israel, “Pick out and take lambs for yourselves according to your families, and kill the Passover lamb. And you shall take a bunch of hyssop, dip it in the blood that is in your basin, and strike the lintel and the two doorposts with the blood that is in the basin. And none of you shall go out of the door of his house until morning. For the Lord will pass through to strike the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the Lord will pass over the door and not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you.”
- After God brought the tenth plague on Egypt (the death of all the firstborn), Pharaoh forced the Israelites to leave.
- Before the Israelites left, they went to their neighbors and asked for gold and silver articles and fine clothes. Moses commanded them to eat the feast and to dress prepared to leave.
- When the Israelites left, they left in a procession, in order of their families.
- After God brought them out of Egypt, He told them to celebrate the Passover feast in remembrance of how God brought them out of Egypt.

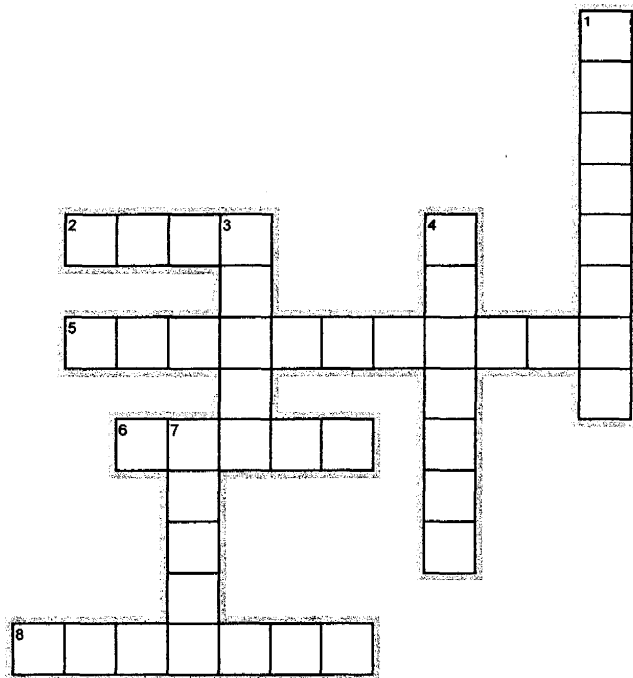
