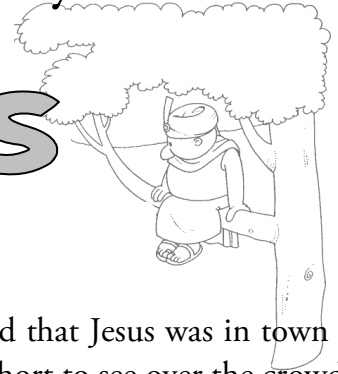


Zacchaeus

Zacchaeus



Luke 19:1-10

- When Zacchaeus, who was a tax collector and a very rich man, heard that Jesus was in town he wanted to see Him. He climbed a sycamore tree because he was too short to see over the crowds.
- When Jesus got to the sycamore tree He called for Zacchaeus to come down because He was to spend the day at his house.
- Zacchaeus was filled with joy. He told Jesus that he would give half of his goods to the poor, and restore four times the amount of anything he had stolen. Jesus declared that salvation had come to Zacchaeus.

- Is it possible for Jesus to change us from bad to good when we believe in Him? (see John 3:3 & I John 1:9)

What does it mean to me:

- What gift does Jesus want to give you?
- Do you do things that Jesus does not like? Ask Jesus to help you!
(I John 1:9)

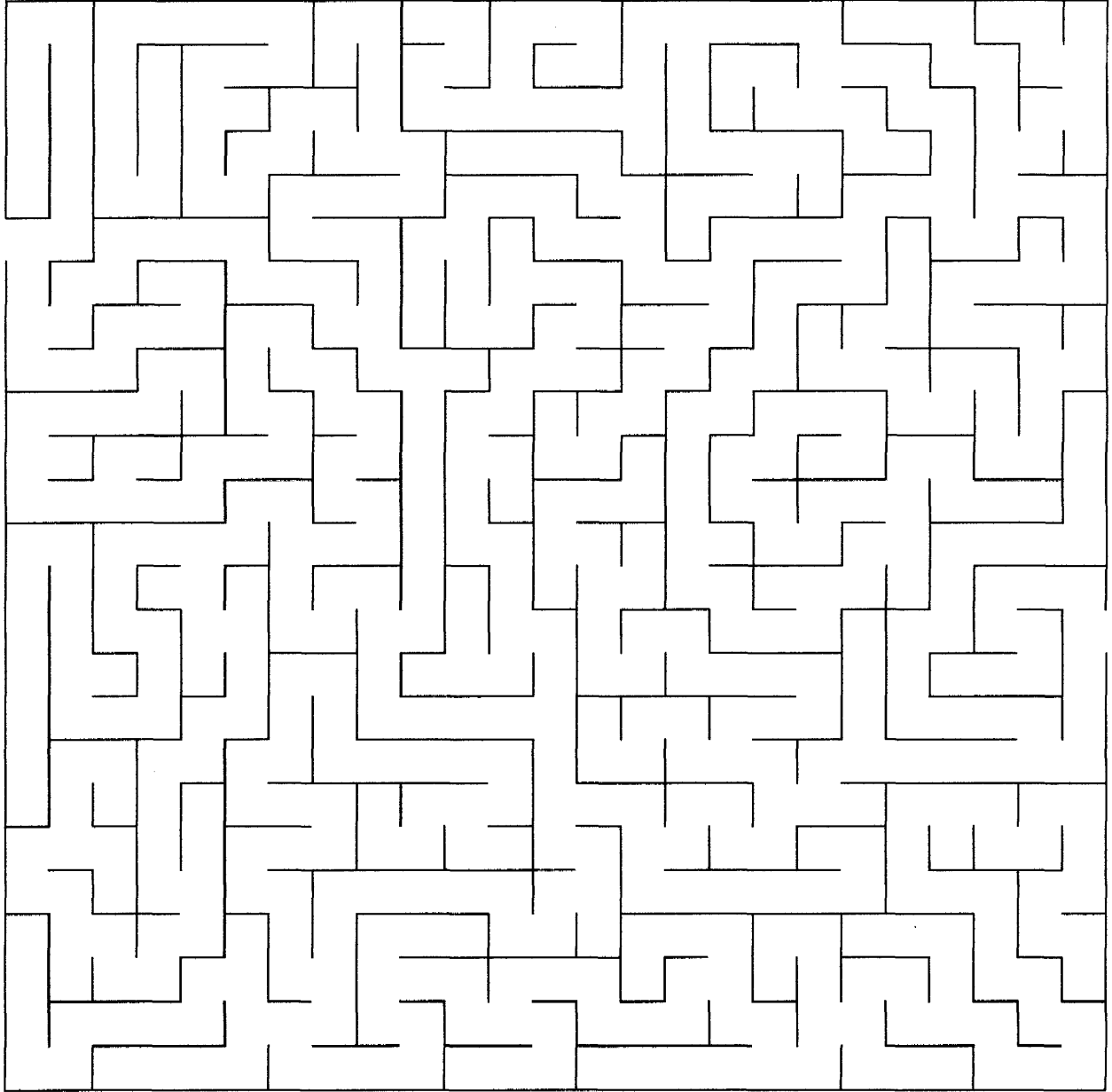
