The Triumphal Entry Into Jerusalem

Matthew 21:1-11; Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:28-40; John 12:12-19

- At Bethany, Jesus sent His disciples to a nearby village to get a colt for Jesus to ride into Jerusalem. As Jesus rode the colt into Jerusalem, the people placed palm branches and their coats on the ground and shouted “Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!”
- When the Pharisees saw the crowd of people shouting, they told Jesus to tell them to stop. Jesus told them that if the people stopped, the stones would cry out instead.

What does the Bible say:

- Why did Jesus ride a colt into Jerusalem?
- What did the people put on the path in front of him?
- What did the people say about Jesus?

What does it mean:

- Why were the people excited?
- Jesus is the Son of God and He is King! What does He want to rule over?

What does it mean to me:

- The people praised God and it pleased God. Is God pleased when you take time to praise Him?
- Does Jesus rule over your heart, your words, your actions?

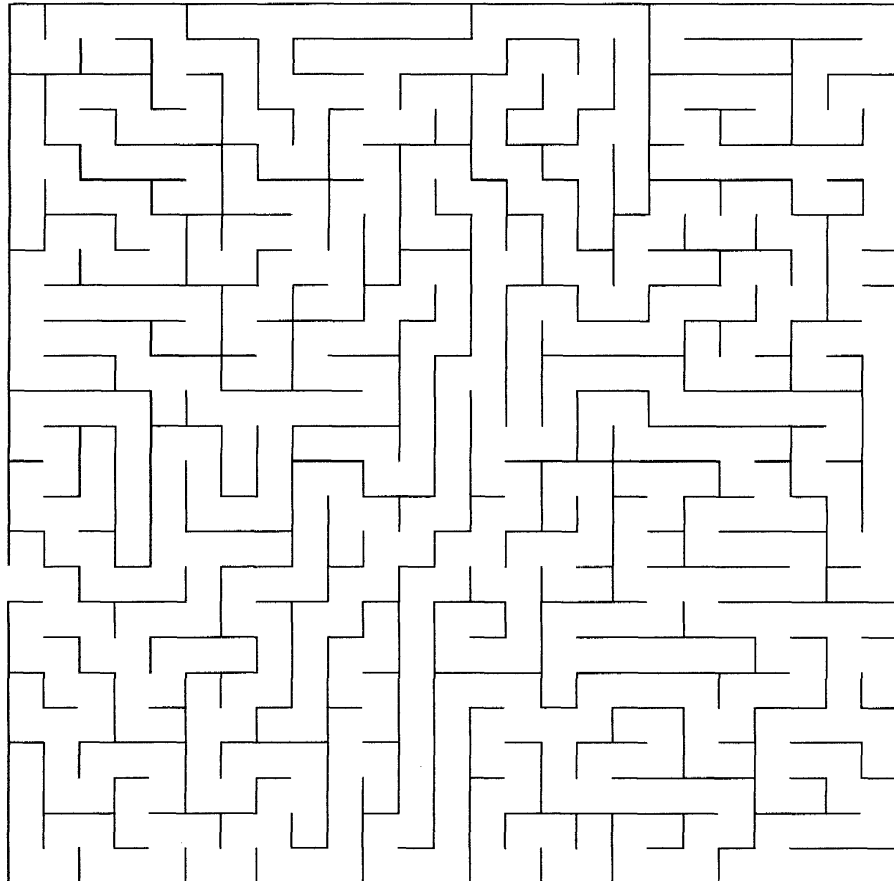
