Luke 2:1-20

- Mary and Joseph went to Bethlehem for the census. They had to stay in a stable because there was no room in the inn. Mary gave birth to Jesus and she wrapped Him in swaddling cloths and laid Him in a manger (feeding trough).
- Angels appeared to some shepherds, declaring that the Savior had been born in Bethlehem and that they would find Him in a manger. After the shepherds had seen the baby Jesus, they told many people what the angels had proclaimed to them.

- Did Mary believe in and trust in God?
- Why was Jesus' birth so important?

- How do you celebrate Jesus' birth?
- Do you pray to God?
- If God wants you to do something special for Him, will you?
- Who is Jesus to you?
