LEADER INFO:

“Leader” organizes the order, layout, and direction of play. They will count off the teams by sending the first 5 kids to team 1, the next 5 to team 2, and the last 5 to team 3, and so on until all kids are in a team. This method keeps friends together!!!!

It is important for the “Leader” to always know how much time is left to leave room for SNACKS.

Yellow needs 5-7 minutes

Red & Blue needs 4- 6 minutes

While kids are at snack the “Leader” and “Assistant Leader” are setting up the next game for the next group.

ANNOUNCER INFO:

“Announcer” is to know how to play the games and explain it to the kids.

Welcomes the kids and makes sure that the kids group correctly at their team line.

Help keep the kids on target for games and snack time

ASSISTANT LEADER INFO:

“Assistant Leader”

Sets up next game with “Leader”

Oversees the “Junior Helpers” and encourages them

Watches for wondering kids.

Collects crafts (putting names & badge # on the craft if needed)

Hands crafts back to the kids during snack time.

JUNIOR HELPERS INFO:

The “Junior Helpers” will be divided into 3 teams with 3 per team.
The teams will stay the same throughout the week

“Junior Helpers” be in line while the announcer gets the kids to line up behind them.

3 of the “Junior Helpers” are designated (for the whole week) as the 3 TEAM LEADERS.
They will hold the team number to help the kids know where they are to be when preparing for their games.

The adult “Assistant Leader” will count off the kids into groups when the kids first arrive and those kids will be sent to the TEAM LEADER. They are to be the example for the other “Junior Helpers” by cheering on kids and helping the kids that may have trouble with any of the games rules or just plain HOW TO PLAY. Grace and laughter are requirements here.

The other remaining “Junior Helpers” are divided up with the team leaders.

One will report to the end of the relay (if on the opposite side of field) to encourage kids, by calling them by name and cheering them on and then having them stay together or sit down (keeps them from wondering). Another will be at the halfway point cheering them on.

Also,

When the kids are getting snacks the “Junior Helpers” will

1. Make a wall to keep them from going outside the game area (this means keeping them out of the parking lot and directing back to the grass between trash cans.
2. Pass out extra waters.
3. At the end of the day they will report to the center tarps and mix in with the kids to help keep disruptions to a minimum.

Keep in Mind:

Some games have down time, i.e. “balloon launcher”, this required making 4 teams for the day instead of the traditional 3 teams. Smaller teams allowed us to play two games at the same time.

2 teams play balloon launch while 2 other teams played feet freeze relay



Please Note:

There will be a few days in which water balloons will need to be filled up. It will be necessary to bring them home and fill them for next day's game.
