



Vision:

During the time allotted for games, you will need to come up with some fun energetic games that will keep the kids involved. This is a time to have fun! We use a lot of relay games that have been tried and tested to make sure they are age appropriate and ones that the kids enjoy.

You will need an adult overseer along with several adult helpers and youth helpers. The leader and helpers need to be energetic and enthusiastic! We have found that mature youth work well in this capacity (with adult overseers). There are lots of little things that need organizing. Make a plan and stick with it. Being ready for each group as they rotate is the key!

You will find many game ideas in this section.

Volunteer Responsibilities:

There will be various responsibilities.

There will be an (adult) leader, (adult) assistant leader, (adult) helpers, and the youth which will be helping in many areas.

The following are a list of some of the various responsibilities that may fall under your specific area.

- 1) Setting up the day's games as directed by games leader, which include many different tasks.*
- 2) Filling water balloons the night before the event and bringing them to the park.*
- 3) Being a support to the overseer as games are being played, which means keeping the children in line, encouraging them, controlling them, playing games with them. Being a good example to all the children.*

4) After each age group's game time, setting up again, and having all supplies ready for the next group.

5) Tearing down games after the day is over, which involves: emptying buckets, gathering up all game supplies and putting them in proper containers, picking up any trash in area, etc.

We would like everyone to arrive at the park each day by *(time)*. for prayer.

During the beginning and ending session, please feel free to sit among the children. This will help with "control issues."

It is very important to encourage the kids. Keep in mind that these little ones are very impressionable. Be careful what you say to them, and what you say when you're around them.

Be careful that this time does not turn into a social time with others. Our purpose is to be there to help the overseer and to minister to the kids.
